Disability Connect is delighted to announce the Parents' Support group meeting in November 2018.

This month we have invited 'GlowKids manager Sonya Sinclair to talk about Conductive Education and their 'Sensory Kindy'.

GlowKids Sensory Kindy is a great learning space for children with Autism and Sensory Processing disorders. At GlowKids, they learn through intensive interaction, sensory experience, play and exploration that strengthens their communication, social and play skills and gross motor and fine motor co-ordination.

Conductive Education is a programme developed specifically to improve the quality of life for people with neurological motor disorders. Through repetition, undamaged parts of the brain can be trained to compensate for those parts of the brain that have been damaged. It teaches co-ordination of movement and to achieve greater independence and self confidence in everyday life. Individual Programmes focus on functional goals such as gross and fine motor skills and co-ordination, social skills, communication (verbal, visual, signing), motivational play and independence using games, music, physical and other activities that are fun.

GlowKids offer free assessment and support for families to meet with their expert therapists and discuss your concerns. They offer individually tailored programmes and small group sizes to enhance progressive learning.
