We are inviting people with Cerebral Palsy / Hōkai Nukurangi, to contribute to the New Zealand Cerebral Palsy Register.

What are the benefits of the NZ Cerebral Palsy Register (NZCPR)?

The Register is able to combine all the health information on people with CP to help health services and disability groups to:

- Understand what living with CP means for different groups (such as Māori or people living in different parts of the country)
- Guide health planning, to make sure all people with CP can access the right health services when they are needed
- Promote research about CP so we can learn about what works in preventing and improving health for all people with CP
- Share important information with you and your whānau

How can I participate?

Participation in the NZCPR is voluntary. Any person with CP can be registered. To get all the NZCPR information:
